 "Let's count the parts in sun-screen - two!" "What rhymes with sand? Hand, band, land!"

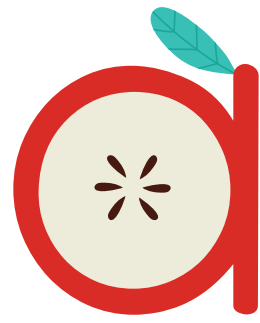
