Launched in 2020, Early Words connects key professionals in healthcare with resources to help families build the early literacy skills of their children. Early Words is currently working with 14 health clinics in Nunavut and Manitoba and provides training and resources for doctors and nurses to offer early literacy counselling to the children under age 5 during routine healthcare appointments. Early Words also provides practical resources, including high quality children's books so families can build early literacy at home.
