THE STORY OF THEIR SUMMER

 One way to help keep your child's reading skills sharp is by having them read a story they know: the story of their summer.

Make a summer scrapbook chronicling their adventures.

Guidelines:

- ★ It can be a story about anything.
- ★ Make sure to leave room for illustrations or photos.
- ★ Write captions for each entry.

Tip: You can help your child write the text - as long as they get to practice by reading it back to you.

How to make your summer scrapbook:

- 1 Gather 3 pages of your choice.
- 2 Fold each page in half.
- 3 Nest the halves inside of each other.
- 4 Staple down the folded edge.



Materials needed:

1. Plain paper (3)
2. Stapler
